## Volleyball Southland Coaches Job Description

Coaching a Volleyball Southland team is a voluntary position. Our volunteer coaches have every right to be given a clear understanding of what coaching entails. The following is the outlines of what is expected from the Head Coach.

### Duties:

- Inform players of all information given to you from the Volleyball Coordinator to be distributed.
- Attend try outs to help with the selections of your squad, and ensure all information of the selected players are gathered and given to the Volleyball Coordinator.
- Inform the Volleyball Coordinator of training request for the season – Please note that not all requests will be accommodated if we do not have the court space.
- Ensure that each player in the squad has read and signed the player code of conduct, filled in the health form as well as the contact form.
- Attend as many training session as possible. If unable to attend you must let the Volleyball Coordinator know.
- Ensure the team respects the building and equipment they are training in and with.
- Keep the Volleyball Coordinator up to date with progress, withdraw and additions to the team.
- Attend scheduled coaching meetings when called. First one will be before our first rep training.
- Responsible for all equipment given and to be returned to the Volleyball Coordinator at the conclusion all tournaments.
- A small report to be done for each tournament – Score, placing and over all written report.

## Volleyball Southland – Coach Code of Conduct Form

In signing this code of conduct form the coach agrees to:

1. Maintain a high standard of conduct on and off the volleyball court at any event or activity and comply with Volleyball Southlands protocols.
2. Avoid any action which may discredit Volleyball Southland and the game of Volleyball whether the Coach is representing Volleyball Southland at the time or not.
3. **Not consume alcohol or drugs at anytime**, no smoking in Volleyball Southland uniform. A zero tolerance approach will be taken if this rule is broken and a Coach's future inclusion in Southland representative teams will be seriously jeopardised. Coaches found to be consuming alcohol, drugs or smoking will immediately removed from the team and sent home at the Coach's own expense.
4. Maintain a continuing high standard of appearance. When representing Southland the correct team uniform must be worn at all times on and off the Volleyball Court, with no exceptions unless a mufti dinner out has been arranged.
5. Take care of all clothing and equipment provided by Volleyball Southland and to return these to Volleyball Southland at the conclusion of the event. Loss of or damage to equipment beyond normal wear and tear shall be charged against the Coach. Equipment and apparel must not be exchanged.
6. Be punctual and regularly attend all training sessions, and team or squad meetings. Coaches must be prepared mentally, physically and technically for all events. Agree to be punctual for all tournaments and competitions and for travel to and from those events.
7. Learn how to referee and score tournament games as all Coach's and players are to do both while competing.
8. Remain in the company of the team from the time of departure to the time of return for all events. Coaches can not go out and meet friends or go out for dinner or drinks without the pre-approval before departure as our player/coach/manager ratios are something we take seriously.
9. To not be alone with players, this is for your own safety. Please ensure the manager or chaperon is always present when you want to talk to the team or an individual and it is to be in a common room not a private room example: dorm room.
10. No coach can select players who have a financial debt with volleyball southland, all debt must be cleared before trials, no exceptions
11. Follow all Volleyball Southlands policies and procedures and any disciplinary action will be done by the Manager after discussion with the Volleyball Southland Board chair or substitute.
